On Monday we plan to begin at the Barn at Stratford (address below) where we will greet you and your camper. A daily schedule with camp sites and activities will be emailed to you in the week or so prior to camp start.

We have access to a refrigerator at each facility with the exception of the Oak Grove Cemetery. Please pack a lunch with that in mind.

Each day we will provide a disposable water bottle and one snack.

Campers will be playing outside during lunch and during their Oak Grove Cemetery Scavenger Hunt. Please be sure they are dressed for these outdoor activities.

Campers may be dressing in period costumes belonging to the Delaware County Historical Society.

We hope that the campers' families will join us Thursday, June 6 at 2:15 p.m. at the Barn at Stratford to share in our celebration of history.
