3rd- 11th grades

This interactive program takes your class on a walking tour of Delaware's south ward.

Mr. Watson Walker will visit your class in advance to inspire the students with stories of the area. Teachers might like to have students research Delaware's early black settlers and later residents and then present their findings while touring the area.





Location:

The walking tour can stand alone or can be the culminating part of a unit of study of the early inhabitants of the neighborhood in the south ward. Students can report their research findings on the people they studied as they walk around the neighborhood.

Length of time:

The walk around the neighborhood is approximately 45-60 minutes.

Fee:

Our program fee is \$50.00 for small groups (up to 50 people), or \$100.00 for larger groups (50+) and increments of \$50 for each group of 50 participants.
